

BYLAWS CHANGES 2021-22 SEASON

1) B10 MATCH REPORTS TO BE FURNISHED

Agreed Changes

- Change B10 for Seniors all reports to midnight Monday
- Juniors to Midnight Tuesday
- Fines may extend to loss of match points in the event a team has more than 3 transgression in one season
- Team List must be entered into MyCricket prior to the toss of the coin

2) C5. (1) QUALIFICATIONS FOR SEMI-FINAL AND FINAL (SENIOR) MATCHES

Agreed Changes

- Any player who does not meet the qualifications **will not** be granted a permit to play under any circumstances.
- Any team that includes a player in contravention of this bylaw shall lose the match in which such a player takes part
- Permits may be considered for the T20 comp (see D29 clause 13)

3) D9. (2) BATTING TIMES - ONE DAY MATCHES – A1 PREMIER GRADE TO C3 GRADE

Agreed Changes: Amend clause to D9 (2) a) (ii)

- Both batting and fielding teams are entitled to complete its full quota of overs irrespective of the fact that a result may have already been achieved. Only if both captains agree can stumps be drawn early once a first innings results as been achieved.

4) D29 T20 PLAYING CONDITIONS

Agreed Changes

- All match results and player stats must be entered into MyCricket within 48 hours following the completion of the match
- Penalties for non-compliance same as bylaw B10

5) D29 T20 PLAYING CONDITIONS

New Wording: Amendment to D29 (13) (d)

SACA/ATCA Dual Registered junior players to continue to play in finals commencing with the Round of 16, must have played at least 4 weeks within the ATCA junior competition to be considered as a qualified club player and not subject to the conditions of a guest player.

6) D29 T20 PLAYING CONDITIONS

Agreed Changes: to D29 Clause (12) and (13)

- Finals qualification for guest players and club players fall under the same conditions
- Guest player can move up grades in finals same as a club player.

7) D37 NAMING AND PLAYING OF A 12TH PLAYER 'B1 to C3' GRADES.

Agreed Changes: Amend clause D37 (b)

- Any senior or junior player that have a dual registration role cannot be used as a slash/12th player

Agreed Changes: Amend clause D37 (c)

- Any team that includes a player in contravention of this rule shall forfeit the match and bonus points in which such a player takes part in

- The opposing team shall receive the forfeit points or the greater of match and bonus points achieved during the match.

8) C5. (1) QUALIFICATIONS FOR SEMI-FINAL AND FINAL (SENIOR) MATCHES

Agreed Changes: Amend C5 (1) 9

- For a dual registered player, who has met the qualification standards to be eligible, he must not have played more than 50% of his total matches in another SENIOR Association

9) D1. LAWS OF CRICKET TO APPLY

Agreed Changes: Add clause (e)

- Play must commence at the scheduled start time with both teams required have 8 players present. Any club found to be in breach of this clause may face a fine not exceeding \$100 for each reported breach.

10) D9. (1) and (3) BATTING TIMES - TWO DAY MATCHES – A1 PREMIER TO B3 GRADES

- Add to clause D9 1 (j) and D9 3 (j) clarifying the 6 over rule does not stop clubs declaring after the 31 minutes cut off time

11) B11. FINAL MATCHES - ALL GRADES

Proposed Change as per attached (combined B11 and B12)

12) B7. FORFEITS AND/OR ABANDONMENT

Agreed Changes to B7 (e)

New Wording

- If a club is unable to field one or more teams then the team or teams forfeiting must be the lowest graded team or teams of the club. Should a club forfeit a match in a grade other than their lowest grade the club will be subject to fines and loss of match points of all the lower graded teams of the relevant competition. For this Bylaw the Senior Two Day Competition and the Limited Over Competition shall be classed as Two Separate Competitions. This bylaw also applies in the T20 competition.

13) C2. 2 (c) DUAL REGISTRATION (SPECIAL PROVISIONS)

New Wording (highlighted in red)

- Dual Registration or the exchange of players is permitted within clubs playing within the ATCA or any **other metropolitan cricket association. This provision cannot be used when the club has a bye**
- SACA clubs fielding teams in the ATCA competition using this clause to benefit other ATCA clubs **will have no restriction on the number of clubs they can exchange players with.**
- This provision places a limit of five (5) players that can be exchanged each round or play in a particular team**
- This bylaw differs from bylaw C2 2 (b) v. in which it allows more than one such player that can be selected to play for a team.**
