Junior players over the age of 15 but under the age of 17 as of September 1st in the current season are allowed to play senior cricket in instances where the forecasted temperature for Adelaide is recorded on the morning of the game as 38°degrees as long as the ATCA has received written consent of their parent/guardian and the club secretary prior to the scheduled start of play. Complete abandonment of the competition will take place where the forecasted temperature for Adelaide is recorded on the morning of the game as 42°degrees or greater
